

First Aid/CPR/AED Virtual Skills with Single Use Training Kit

Train and test remotely and safely

Single Use Training Kit allows you to continue lifesaving training while complying with public health guidance. Students participate in training from the comfort of their home or workplace.

Convenient and easy to use, the Single Use Training Kit contains all the required equipment for your training session with no need for return after one-time use.

Virtual skills training works best with blended learning programs.

How it works

- Schedule a virtual training class at least 10 business days in advance. Single Use Training Kits are sent to the students' preferred location prior to class.
- 2. Students and instructor conduct skills practice and testing via web conference using Red Cross virtual skills guidance.
- 3. Instructor updates the students' records in the Red Cross Learning Center and a two-year certificate is issued.

Single Use Training Kit includes:

Lightweight, inflatable adult manikin Simulated AED trainer First aid training supplies:

- 1 CPR face shield
- 2 4" x 4" gauze pads
- 1 roller bandage
- 1 pair of disposable gloves

Course and instruction fees are in addition to the Single Use Training Kit and will be charged separately.
